**ADULT APPRENTICES
UNDER THE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION GENERAL ON-SITE MODERN AWARD 2010**

A. IF AN APPRENTICE IS ALREADY EMPLOYED, AND 21 YEARS OF AGE OR MORE, WHEN THE APPRENTICE ENTERS INTO AN APPRENTICESHIP

If an apprentice is 21 years of age or more at the time of commencing their apprenticeship and already employed, the adult apprentice will continue to receive the rate of pay applicable to their previous classification.

B. IF AN APPRENTICE IS A NEW STARTER AND 21 YEARS OF AGE OR MORE WHEN THE APPRENTICE ENTERS INTO AN APPRENTICESHIP

If an apprentice is 21 years of age or more when they start their apprenticeship the apprentice will be paid **no less than the CW/ECW1(a) rate in the Award** (in the table below)
or the Apprentice Rate (see the 1st page for apprentice rates) **WHICHEVER IS THE GREATER**
